Emergency management professionals are invited to submit presentations for inclusion in this year's program.

The 2017 Vermont Emergency Preparedness Conference is sponsored by the Vermont Department of Public Safety's Division of Emergency Management & Homeland Security. The event draws emergency management professionals from across Vermont who attend educational sessions, hands-on workshops and two full days of conference presentations, keynotes and plenary sessions.

The conference planning committee is seeking presentations that focus on best practices, lessons learned, practical application of concepts, innovative technology or practice, participant interaction, and advancing partnerships in

Emergency Management.

Speakers should be dynamic presenters of a professional caliber and have previous speaking or teaching experience. All presentations will be allotted 45 minutes for presentation including questions. Submissions requiring additional time, multiple speakers/panelists, or concepts outside of the conference suggested sessions will be considered on an individual basis.
