INCIDENTS AND EVENTS:

- Georgia - 35 gallons of hydraulic fluid spilled. ANR notified and VT Hazmat Response Team notified.
- Burlington - 1 gallon of motor oil spilled and 1.5 gallons of coolant spilled. ANR notified.
- Windsor - Mount Ascutney Hospital without water due to water main break. VDH notified.
- The National Weather Service has issued a Wind Advisory, Wind Chill Warning and Wind Chill Advisory for late today into Friday morning for all Vermont Counties.

RESOURCES DEPLOYED:

- Brattleboro – American Red Cross provided client services to two people displaced by fire.
