2. Project Title:

Bethel FD Swift Water Team Equipment

3. Problem Statement:

The present dry suits for the Bethel area swift water team are nearing the end of their useful life and do not adequately fit the needs of the swift water team. Interest in swift water training by other area fire departments (Barnard, Stockbridge, South Royalton) continues to grow, there currently being 20 certified members. Some of the present suits are in need of repair and there are not enough suits available for the growing swift water team.

There is presently no backup for the highline rescue kit in the event the present set fails during a rescue attempt. In addition, the Bethel Fire Department now houses two swift water boats (one boat being owned by Barnard), but only one highline rescue kit. The availability of this equipment is critical to the operation of the swift water team. Although the Bethel area team is not part of the Vermont Urban Search & Rescue Team, the team does fill a void since the closest swift water team for this area is 20 miles away.

4. Project Goals And Objectives:

In the fall of 2014, utilizing the 2014 Special Operations Grant, the Bethel Fire Department purchased a new swift water boat to replace the one that is nearing the end of its useful life. The objective, utilizing funds from this grant, is to purchase new dry suits and a back-up highline rescue kit so that the Bethel team is better equipped for swift water rescues in this area.

5. Project Description:

The Bethel Fire Department would utilize funding from this grant to purchase 10 sets of dry suits and a back-up highline rescue kit. The Department prefers to use Dive Rescue for purchase of this equipment since they are an established, trusted vendor with the Department. Additionally, the prices are guaranteed for the time we anticipate making the purchase and the overall total cost could be less than the quoted prices, primarily dependent on the sizes for the dry suits. The Department holds trainings on an ongoing basis to ensure that members are adequately prepared in the event of a rescue. The next swift water training will be held in the Spring 2015.

Support from the community towards the Bethel Fire Department in general is strong. Appropriation requests at Bethel Town Meeting have been met with unanimous support by Bethel voters. Should this grant be awarded, the Bethel Fire Department will issue a press release to announce the award and to notify the public of our continued efforts in emergency preparedness.

Assuming a grant award is made in September 2015, all purchases would be completed in the month of October. Once copies of the cancelled checks are received, and all associated training is completed, the project would be closed out. Estimated project completion is no later than December 2015.

7. Project Evaluation Plan:

For this project, the Bethel Fire Department would utilize the Activity Evaluation method to determine the effectiveness of implementing this project. This will be done by maintaining or increasing the number of swift water trained personnel (presently at 20 members).

- B. Responsibilities of all "Department Heads," Foremen, "On-Site Managers," and Town Officers:**
1. Volunteer budget assistance to the Town Manager, to provide information about the needs envisioned in advance of forthcoming fiscal years, or anticipated departures from historic trends.
 2. Upon budgets being approved by the Selectboard in its capacity as the Legislative Body of the Town (or in its capacities as the Board of Commissioners of the Water, Wastewater, or Solid Waste Programs), review applicable budgets and provide feedback to the Town Manager regarding the suitability of budget(s) for the specific department or Town Office.
 3. Support the budgets as may be reasonably possible by responding to questions from citizens or others, and be prepared to offer information as may be necessary for voter consideration of budgets at the Annual Town Meeting.
 4. Comply with the "Methodology" of this Procurement Policy:
 - a. All procurements shall be logically supportable by reference to specific budget line items.
 - b. Procurements supportable by budget line items which are less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) may be made by employees in order to perform day-to-day duties, unless a directive has been issued by the Town Manager to "freeze" all procurements which do not have prior approval from the Town Manager.
 - c. Except as is provided immediately below herein, all procurements in excess of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) in value shall be approved in advance by the Town Manager and an understanding established with the Town Manager as to who will complete the acquisition; Exception: if in good faith, an employee or Town Officer believes an urgency exists, under threat of which it is believed that undue damage to people or property will occur unless immediate action is taken, departure may be taken from this policy to the extent considered reasonable by the employee or Town Officer to minimize, avert or eliminate the perceived damage, provided that explanation of the matter is made to the Town Manager at the earliest reasonable opportunity.
- C. Responsibilities of the Town Manager under this Procurement Policy:**
1. Undertake procurements in a timely manner to provide for the needs and necessity of the public, and in support of Town budgets and programs.
 2. Determine the most appropriate means to make any and all procurements in compliance with all local, State, and federal laws, and with sensitivity to the interests and directives of the Selectboard.

WHEREAS, Presidential Policy Directive (PPD)-8 describes the approach to national preparedness, including the National Preparedness System, as the instrument the nation will employ to build, sustain, and deliver core capabilities; and

WHEREAS, the NIMS standardized procedures for managing personnel, communications, facilities and resources improve the Town of Bethel ability to utilize federal funding to enhance local and state agency readiness, maintain first responder safety, and streamline incident management processes; and
