Description:

This course is designed to enable personnel to operate efficiently during an incident or event within the Incident Command System. This course focuses on the management of single resources.

This course is designed to provide overall incident management skills rather than tactical expertise.

Objectives include:

- Describe the Incident Command System (ICS) organization appropriate to the complexity of the incident or event.
- Use ICS to manage an incident or event.

Target Audience:

First responder supervisors, Emergency Management Directors and Coordinators, School Principals, Superintendents, school crisis planning team members and other school key decision makers and those who would likely be assigned as unit leaders and above within an ICS structure, or as directed by the chief executive of the agency.

Cost:

- There is NO cost to attend this course.
- Lodging, meals and travel are the responsibility of the participant.

Notes:

- Participants who attend all hours required of this course and successfully pass a final exam will receive a Certificate of Completion.
- This course meets NIMS Baseline Training requirements for ICS200.
- Late registrations may be accepted on a case-by-case basis.

ICS 100 - Introduction to Incident Command System - had to have completed this course at minimum 3 months prior to registration.


